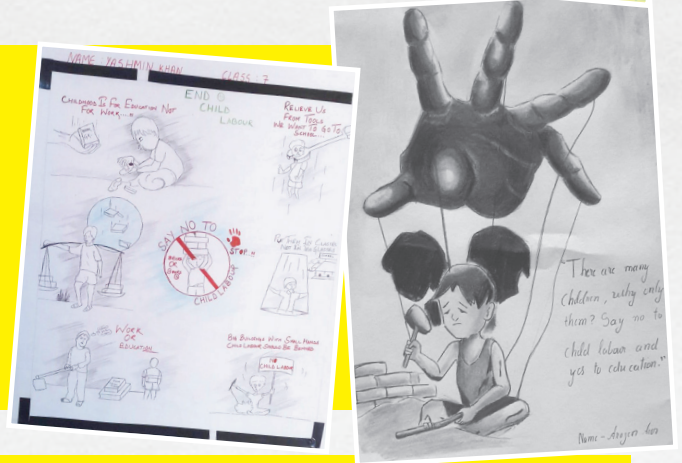
COVID-19 AWARENESS (SOP) PROGRAM FOR HOSTELLERS - 19TH APRIL 2021
