A one-day training & demonstration on winter crop production technology was held at Rajeshwari Karuna School Tuli on 7th November 2022 at the school premises. The resource persons were Dr. Keviletsu Khate. Senior Scientist and Head, Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Mokokchung, Ms. Khekali Sema, Asst. Chief Technical Officer, Horticulture KVK, and Ms. Imtisenla Asst. Chief Technical Officer, Agronomy KVK.

The team also went on to demonstrate how to prepare and care for crop nurseries and the transplantation process.
